- Regular rate - \$24 per night, up to eight people with one RV/trailer or two tents
- Adults 55+ - \$18 per night for adults age 55 or older

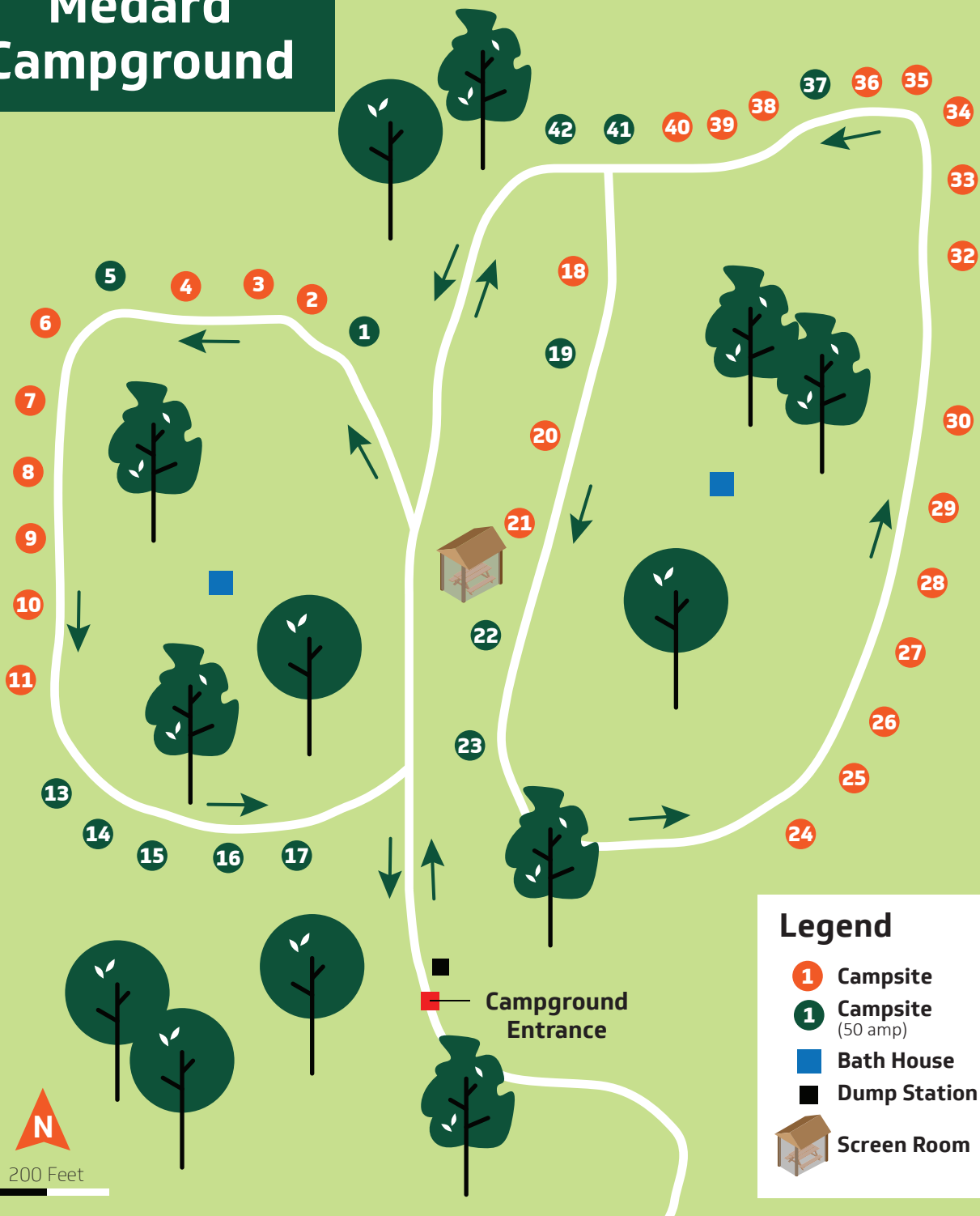

## Welcome to Edward Medard campground.

To help you enjoy your stay and to ensure your safety, please follow these guidelines:

- Camper registration hours are 8 a.m. until one hour before the park closes.
- Quiet hours are 10 p.m. – 8 a.m.
- Check-out time is 11 a.m. To extend your stay, you must reregister by 10 a.m.
- Intoxicants and intoxicated persons are prohibited within the park or on park property. Parties possessing or consuming intoxicants will be asked to leave.
- The campsite registrant must be camping at the site, and will be responsible for all site guests, the condition of the site, and adherence to all rules. Valid ID and vehicle registration required.
- A maximum of two tents or one tent and one RV, eight people, and three registered vehicles are permitted per site.
- All garbage must be taken to the dumpster, at the entrance of the campground. Please do not burn garbage in fire pits.
- Do not attach anything to the trees including clotheslines, hammocks, lights, etc.
- All plants and animals are protected by State and County laws.
- Pets must be in your control at all times and on a 6-foot or shorter, non-retractable leash. Pets are not allowed inside facilities.
- Use the dump station for disposing of grey water.
- Extinguish fires before going to bed or leaving your campsite.
- Failure to comply with all park rules and ordinances will result in the removal and/or trespassing of the entire party.
