



Contractor License Updated Guidance

Pursuant to State of Florida [House Bill 735](#), local jurisdictions/counties may issue local licensure for license types which mirror a license offered by the [Florida Department of Business & Professional Regulation \(DBPR\)](#). Trades regulated by the State of Florida and/or work which requires a permit in this county requires a valid contractor license. Aluminum Structure	General, Building, Residential, Specialty Structure Contractor (FAC 61G4-15.015) or Local Specialty Aluminum Structure
Carpentry – valid until 7/1/2023	License no longer required unless work requires a permit. Permitted work requires General, Building, Residential
Concrete – valid until 7/1/2023	License no longer required unless work requires a permit. Permitted work requires General, Building, Residential
Demolition	General, Building, Residential, Demolition Specialty Contractor (FAC 61G4-15.038) or Local Specialty Demolition
Drywall	General, Building, Residential, Specialty Drywall Contractor (FAC 61G4-15.017) or Local Specialty Drywall
Garage Door Installation – valid until 7/1/2023	General, Building, Residential, Specialty Structure Contractor (FAC 61G4-15.015) or Local Specialty Aluminum Structure
Glass & Glazing	General, Building, Residential, Specialty Glass and Glazing (FAC 61G4-15.018) or Local Specialty Glass & Glazing
Hurricane Shutters – valid until 7/1/2023	General, Building, Residential, Specialty Structure Contractor (FAC 61G4-15.015) or Local Specialty Aluminum Structure
Insulation	License no longer required
Irrigation	Plumbing, Specialty Irrigation Contractor (FAC 61G4-15.035) or Local Specialty Irrigation
Marine Contractor	General, Building, Specialty Marine Contractor (FAC 61G4-15.033) or Local Specialty Marine
Masonry – valid until 7/1/2023	License no longer required unless work requires a permit. Permitted work requires General, Building, Residential
Painting	License no longer required
Paving	License no longer required
Plaster & Stucco – valid until 7/1/2023	License no longer required unless work requires a permit. Permitted work requires General, Building, Residential
Siding, Windows & Doors – valid until 7/1/2023	General, Building, Residential, Specialty Glass and Glazing (FAC 61G4-15.018), Specialty Structure (FAC 61G4-15.015), or Local Aluminum Structure
Signs, non-electrical – valid until 7/1/2023	General, Building
Solar – valid until 7/1/2023	General, Building, Residential
Structural Steel – valid until 7/1/2023	General, Building, Residential
Tile & Marble	License no longer required
Waterproofing, Guniting & Sandblasting – valid until 7/1/2023	License no longer required – for questions email minnest@HCFLGov.net

- **Local Specialty** – application instructions located on [Contractor Licensing page](#). Valid only in Hillsborough County.
- **State Registered** – application instructions located on [Contractor Licensing page](#). Valid only with jurisdiction approval.
- **State Certified** – apply via the [Department of Business & Professional Regulation \(DBPR\)](#). Valid statewide.
