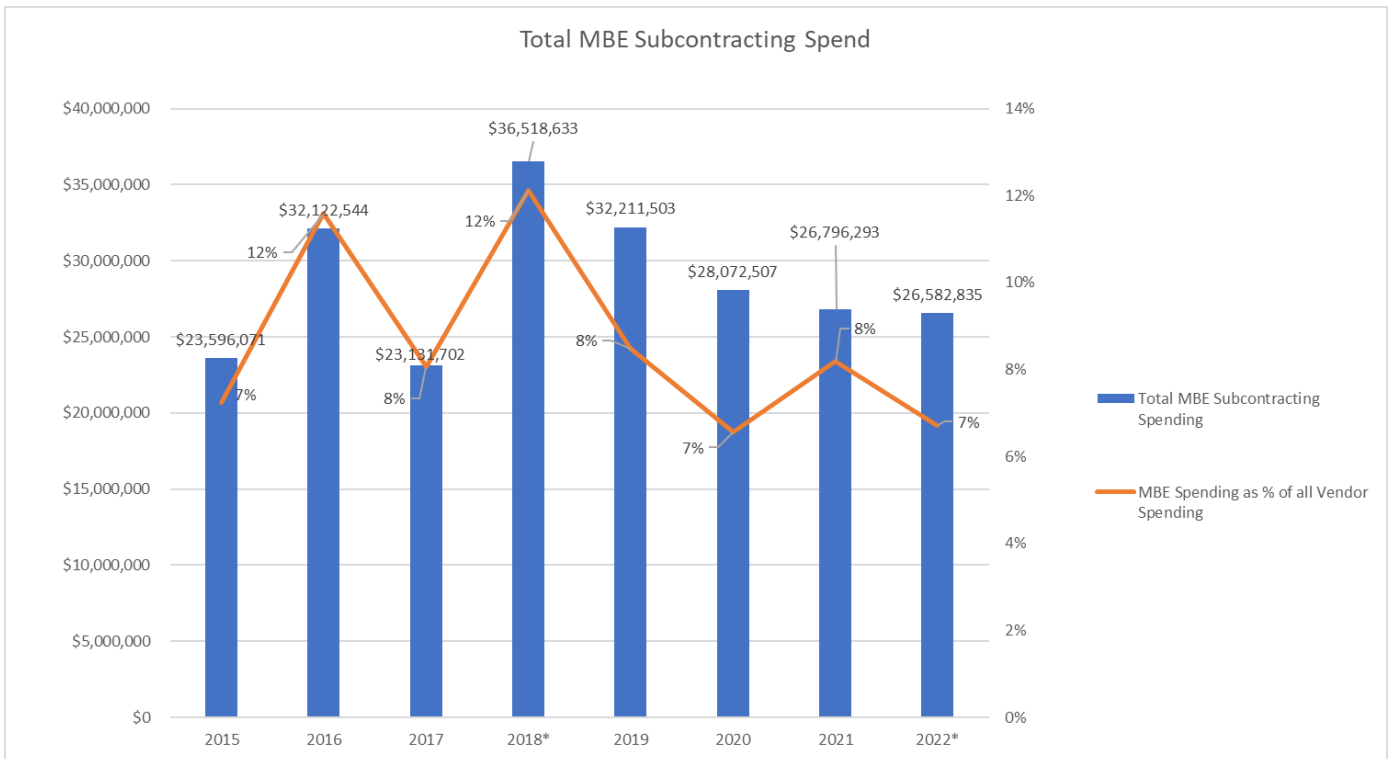


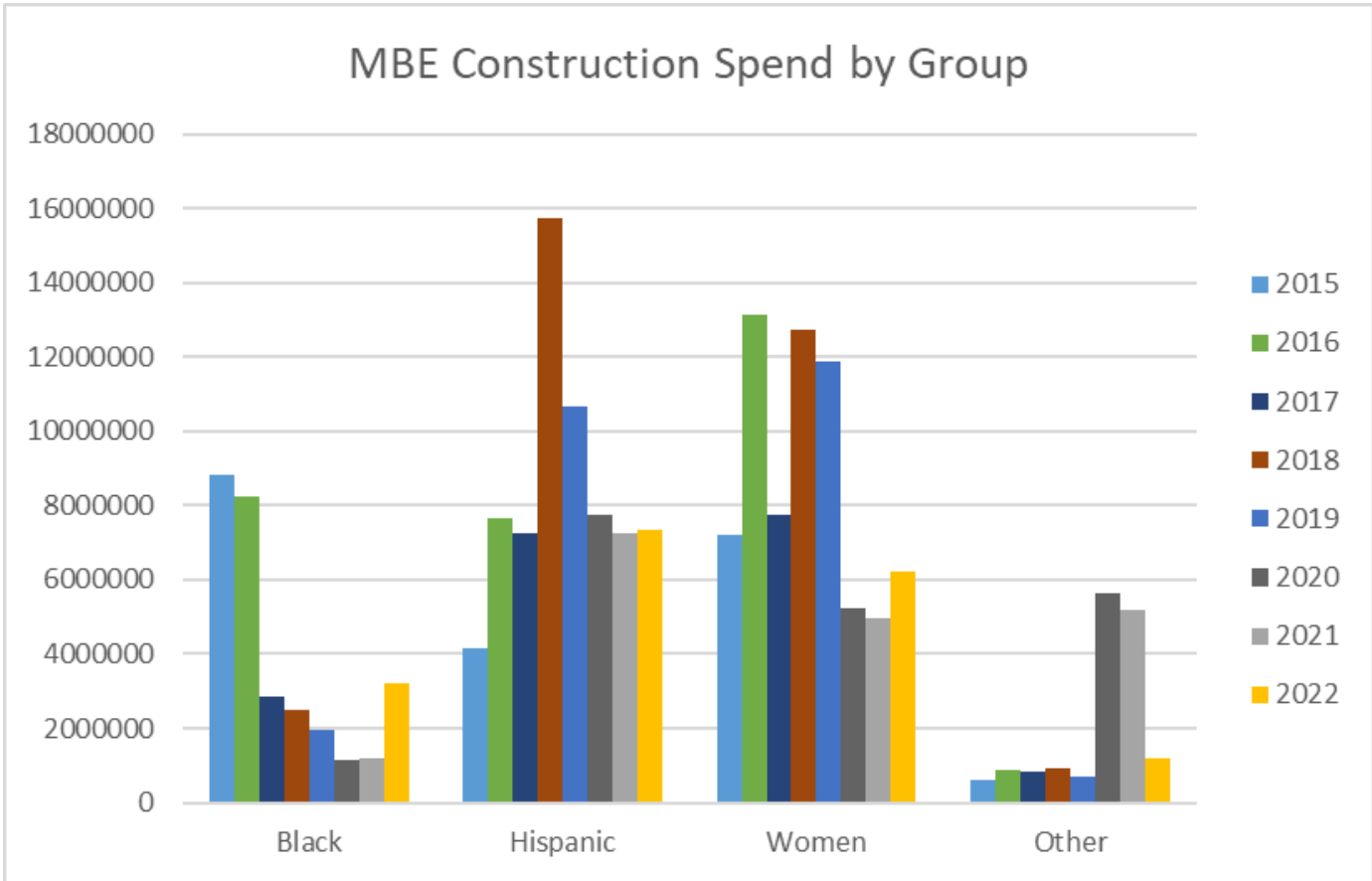
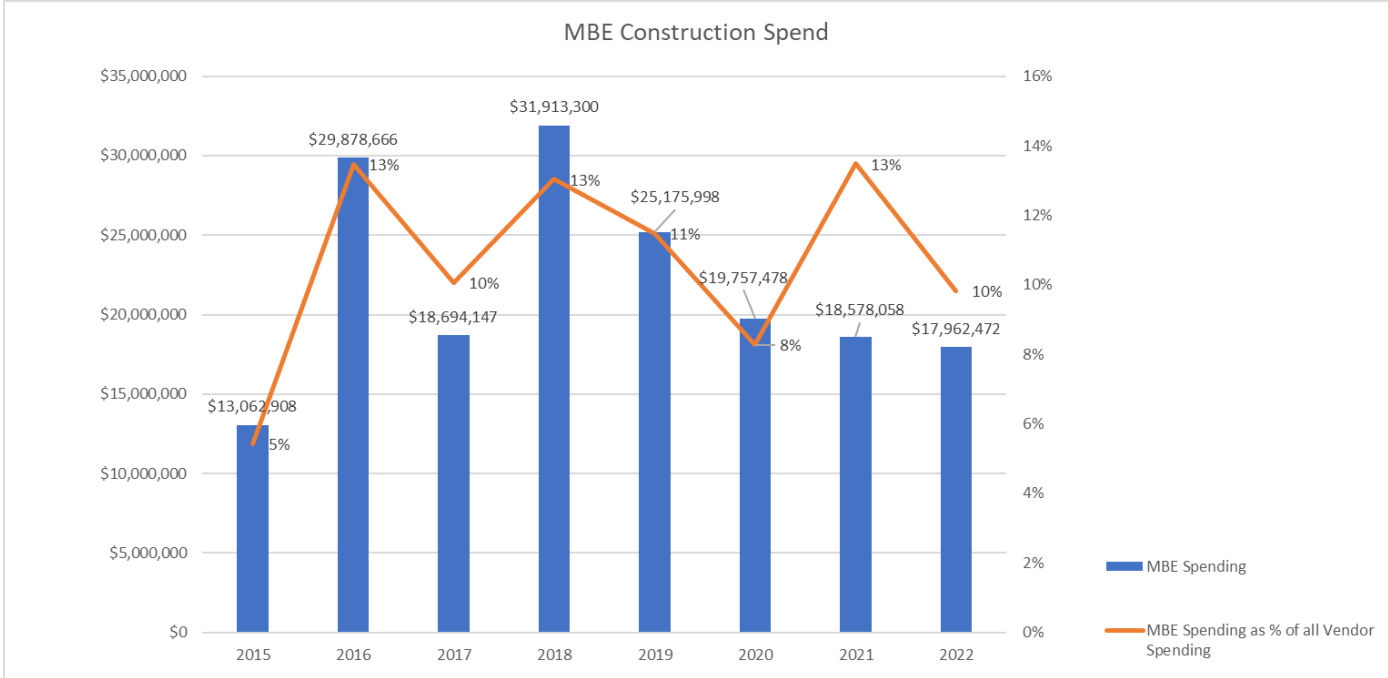
### MBE and SBE Utilization Data FY 22

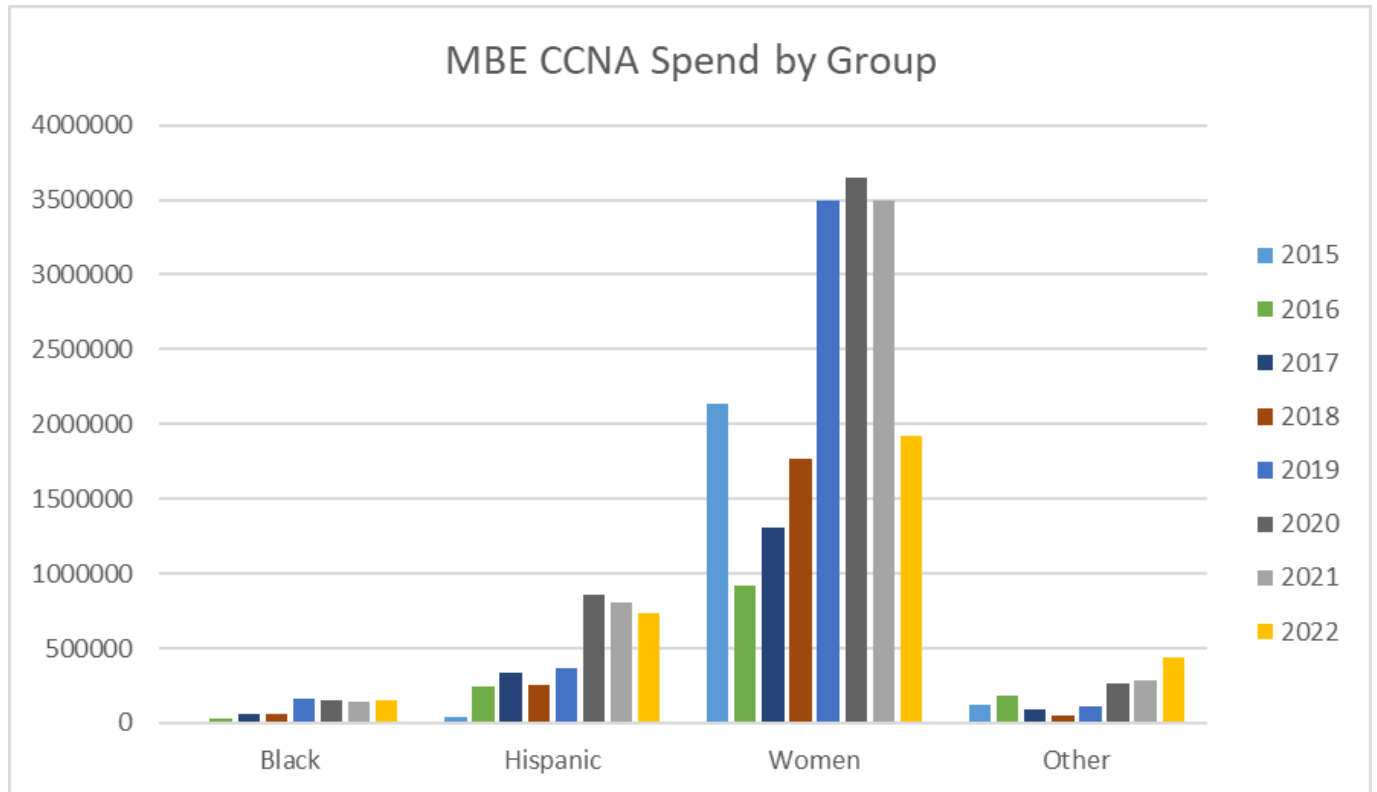
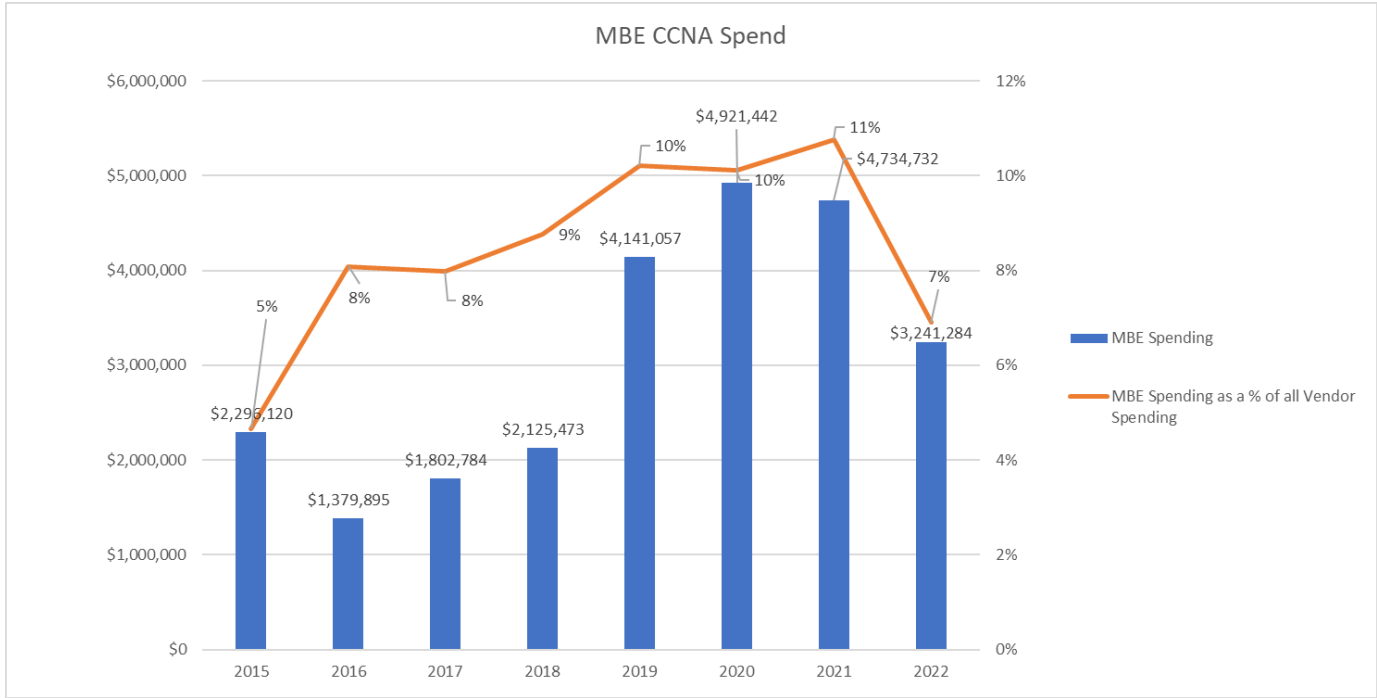
The following data illustrates Hillsborough County’s minority and small business utilization in terms of real dollars spent and as a percentage of total County spending during the same time period. There is also a breakdown provided showing trends in construction, CCNA and P-Card spending – the areas where our certified minority and small businesses do most of their business – and in spending by vendor group type. Following this information, are graphs depicting the number and dollar value of SBE contracts, as well as a chart containing information on the number of new MBE and SBE firms joining the programs.

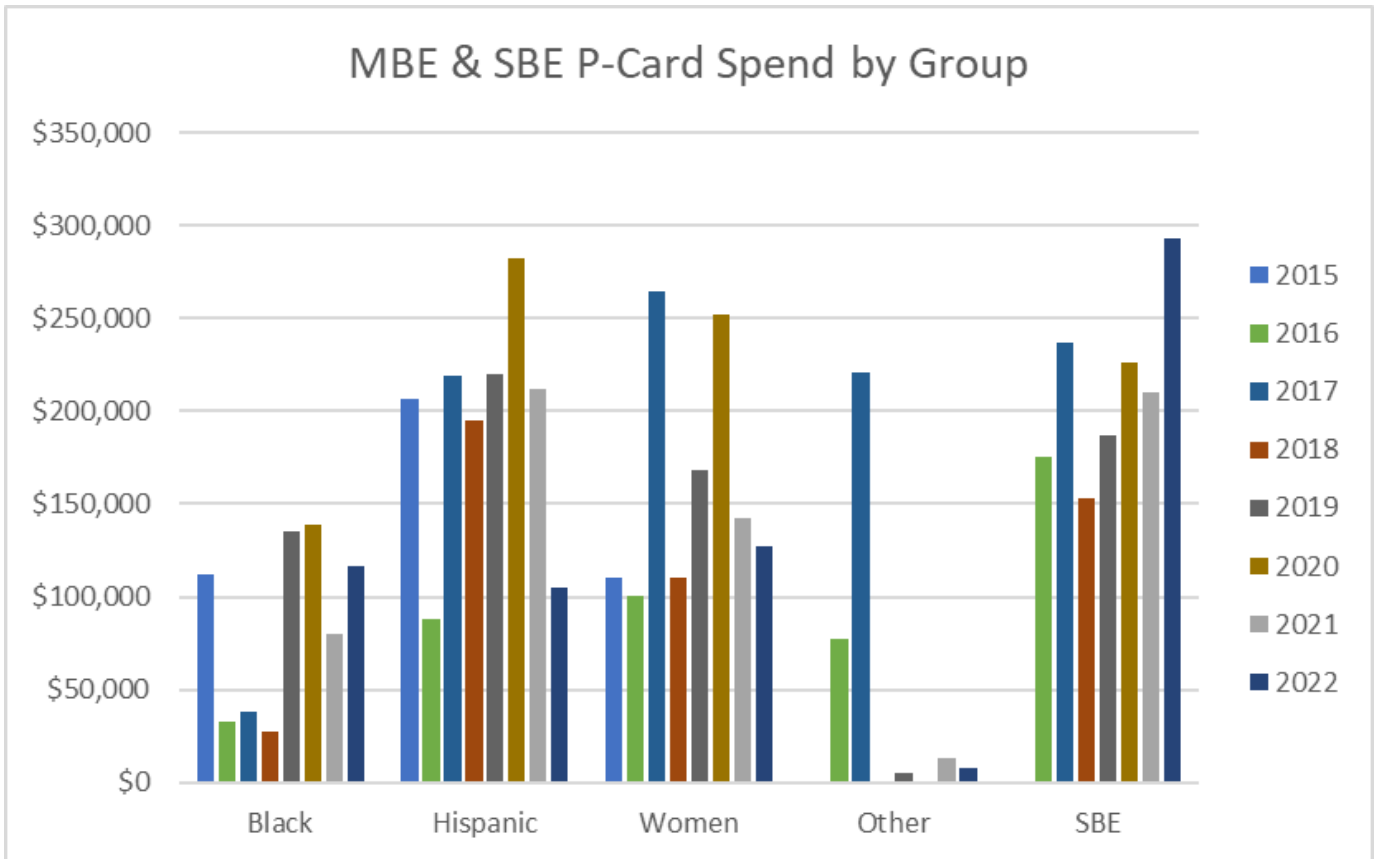
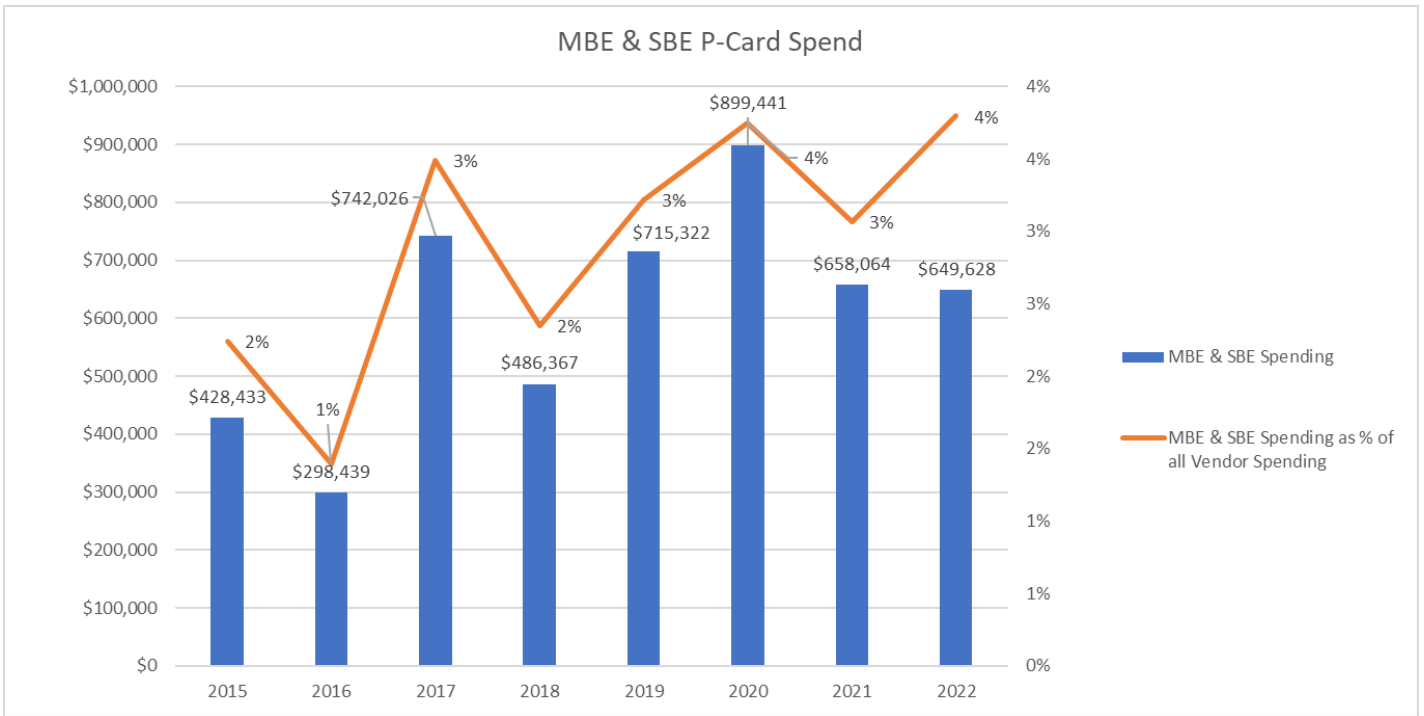


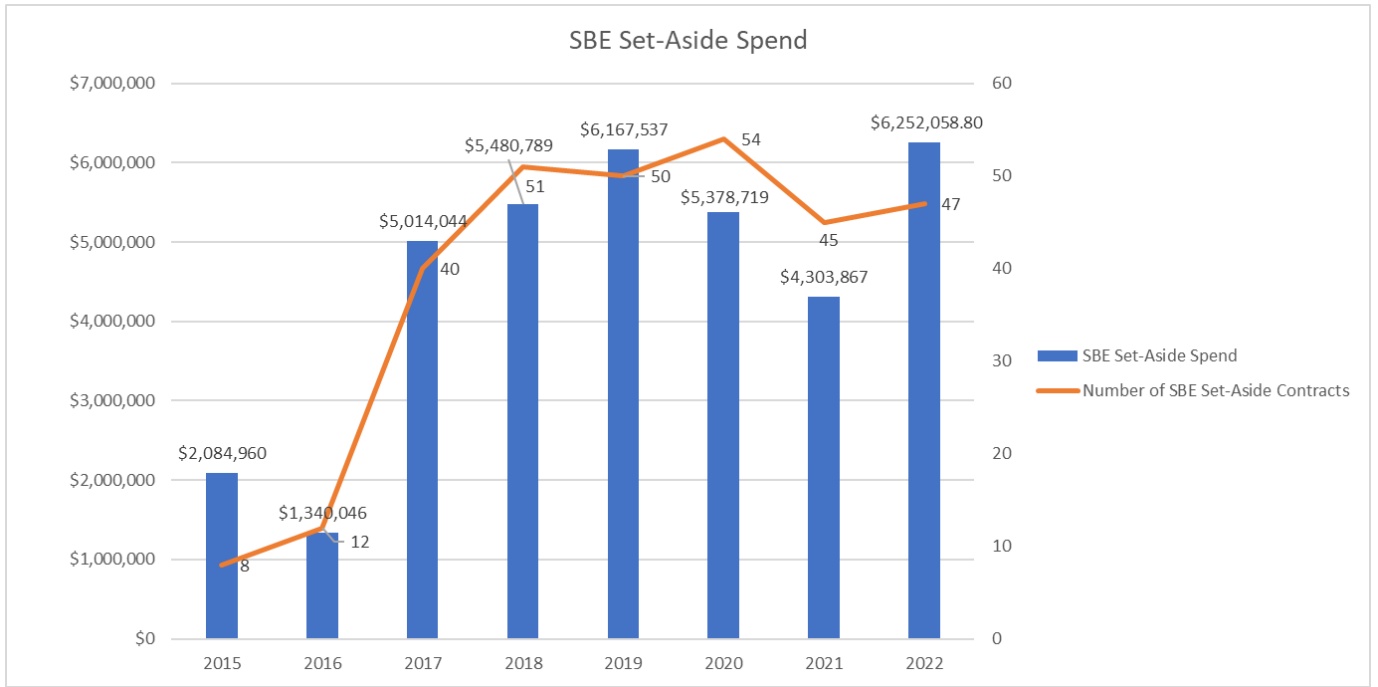
\*2018 was a year of exceptional spending by the county as a result of several major wastewater projects, including the Design Build Northwest Regional Water Reclamation Facility Expansion. \* 2022 there were payment delays due to upgrade and migration to Oracle Cloud and several month backlog with the Clerk’s office due to high volume utilization of the Emergency Rental Assistance Program, which are reflected on the numbers reported.











\*The large increase in contracts is due to proactive engagement with user departments for identification of set-aside projects. The Economic Development Department looks forward to sustaining this level of partnership in the future.
